Combatting Eating Disorders in Ontario Act, 2018

Bill 29 2018 is An Act with respect to digitally altered or retouched photographs and videos, the recognition of actions related to eating disorders and the establishment of an eating disorder awareness campaign.

ALTERATION OR RETOUCHING OF VIDEOS OR IMAGES (S. 2) - applies to persons who publish certain photographs or videos for a commercial purpose in which a person's image has been digitally altered or retouched. They are required to ensure that the photograph or video contains text indicating that it has been altered or retouched. This does not apply to persons engaged in the commercial film, television or video industry.

INSPECTORS (S. 3) - provides for the appointment of inspectors and for the making of complaints.

REVIEW OF REGULATIONS (S. 4) - requires the Minister of Government and Consumer Services to review regulations related to the commercial film, television and video industry and make recommendations. This may include recommendations to include disclaimers similar to those required by section 2.

EATING DISORDER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN (S. 5) - requires the Minister of Government and Consumer Services to conduct an annual eating disorder awareness campaign.

AWARDS RE: REDUCTION IN PREVALENCE OF EATING DISORDERS (S. 6) - allows the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care to give awards to persons that have taken meaningful action to reduce the prevalence of eating disorders.

REGULATIONS (S. 7) - sets out the Minister of Government and Consumer Service's regulation-making powers.
